Barsham Farmers Market consists of a core of regular producers, some of whom have been with us since we started. An average of 25 stalls at every market offer a wide selection of meat including pork,



beef, lamb, poultry, venison, with turkey & goose at Christmas, and of course sausages. There is also seasonal fruit & vegetables, bread, apple juice, home-made pies &



cakes, fish, free range eggs, jams, chutney plus lots more. A number of plant growers offer shrubs, perennials, fruit trees, herbs, vegetables and bed-



ding varieties. Craft stalls specialising for example in bags & scarves, wood carvings, wrought iron work, greetings cards & jewellery can also be found at the market.





Barsham, a genuine farmers market and the first in North Suffolk, opened in August 1999. It is now often referred to as the “friendly market” with some customers and producers having attended regularly from the beginning. Organised by Liz Harvey, together with partner David Miller, it is sited in buildings on their arable farm. Customers buy directly from the local producer and therefore are able to ask questions for instance on animal welfare, pesticide control, cultivation or anything else to do with production methods. The food is fresh and therefore much more flavoursome. Its is altogether a unique shopping experience.



# ***Barsham Wood***



Barsham Wood workshop is open at the market and certainly worth a look. There are many items on display for sale including garden furniture, bird boxes & tables, ornaments and second hand books. Virtually anything crafted from wood can be made to order by the clients working with the New Thresholds Charity. For example, dovecotes, stairways, little rocking horses and so on.
